# Update from the Chair

## Update from the Executive Director

Dear IABC Members,

# I have been honored to serve as your interim Executive Director since November of 2019.

At that time the focus was on learning IABC's mission and operations, working closely with the staff team to ensure timely deliverables of member benefits. The scope of IABC's programs and services was eye-opening in terms of range and depth of offerings.

In January, following due diligence research into the association management model, the IEB voted to enter into a professional services agreement with SmithBucklin effective July 1. This partnership will provide strategic and operational expertise in an adaptable service model.

An early highlight for me was attending Leadership Institute (LI) in February in Austin, TX. It was wonderful to see the energy and enthusiasm of IABC chapter and regional leadership in action. The distances that attendees traveled was a testament to the value of this peer connection. Programming was outstanding, as was the networking. I left LI feeling more informed and connected to the membership; the timing also corresponded to the operational launch of the transition.

We thought change was a constant, especially for IABC in 2019 and in early 2020...then just a few weeks following LI, unprecedented change occurred. Life as we knew it was altered, personally and professionally, with the COVID-19 pandemic. IABC responded with a series of activities to





support our members: a COVID-19 Resource page to provide change management tools; Catalyst content Shifted to thought leadership to support business disruption; The Hub became a critical communication tool to share challenges & solutions; use of all of these resources grew immediately, showing the value of IABC membership in challenging times. A 50% membership discount was offered March through June to support those who needed IABC more than ever.

Efforts Shifted to pivot World Conference to a virtual event. Many volunteer and staff hours resulted in a high quality event with top programming and networking opportunities, now available year round as a professional development resource. If you and your team haven't experienced VWC 2020, know that is available all year, along with other educational resources from the Academy

I want to express my appreciation to the IABC staff team for their commitment to a successful VWC and transition. Their focus was on IABC and you, the members, to ensure an efficient hand-off of operations. Their commitment never wavered.

Looking forward to a busy and energetic second half of 2020 in support of you, our members.




# GCCC update

The Global Communication Certification Council (GCCC) continues to grow the Strategic Communication Management Professional (SCMP) and Communication Management Professional (CMP) certifications.

In June 2019, 18 test takers sat for certification exams at World Conference in Vancouver. Following that success, in 2019–20, exams were offered seven times in Canada, four times in the States, twice in Australia, as well as once each in India, Kenya, and South Africa.

In 2019, 32 CMPs earned their designation, along with 40 SCMPs. In 2020, there are exams scheduled for 11 sites, following postponements due to COVID-19.

The GCCC is working in partnership with Scantron to revise the SCMP exam format, ensuring our exams are in line with the scheme of the program, the current climate of the field, and the most up to date trends in communication. As of June 2020, ANSI will begin the decision-making process regarding accreditation of the CMP program. The GCCC has worked diligently to meet all of the requirements to earn this prestigious endorsement.

## New 2019-2020 offerings

#### **Tools & Templates**

IABC's performance in 2019/20 included both growth and transformational change that further established IABC as the top association to serve communication professionals from all over the world and propelled the organization as a thought leader in the communication industry.

Programs like the GCCC certification program grew by 20%. A new expanded Hub, IABC's online forum for members, also grew to a high of over 7,600 active users since its launch in 2018. The former Communication World magazine was recast as Catalyst, including a weekly publication and extensive online content center, with a library of over 100 webinars.

Webcasts articles, podcasts, templates and reports on critical and current issues faced by communication professionals. The prestigious Gold Quill Awards program brought in more than 500 entries, resulting in 203 Awards conferred honoring communication campaigns from around the world. With at-capacity attendance nearly 90% overall satisfaction the World Conference in Vancouver was one of the most successful in IABC's history.





Through the IABC Academy and industry partners, we delivered both online and in-person training and education tailored to advance key learning on current and critical issues, as well as opportunities to build skills and elevate careers for communication professionals.

Finally, to support IABC to grow and serve its members, as well as the whole communication profession far into the future, IABC brought on the **SmithBucklin** management team to secure a long and prosperous future for the association.

### IABC Foundation award recipients

During the 2020 Leadership Institute, the IABC Foundation trustees awarded five applicants Gift of Excellence grants to allow them to seek certification as a Communication Management Professional (CMP) or Strategic Communication Management Professional (SCMP) through the Global Communication Certification Council (GCCC). The grant covers the application fee, exam fee and one-year renewal fee, totaling US\$600 for each person.

The IABC Foundation is particularly interested in helping to expand availability of certification where currency discrepancies or developing economies may make it financially difficult for members to take part. IABC members living and working in areas designated as developing nations by the World Bank and International Monetary Fund, as well as those living in areas significantly impacted by a natural disaster, received the highest priority in the disbursement of Gift of Excellence grant funds. All applicants demonstrating financial need are considered.


